Dear Ms. Harrison:

The Marine Mammal Commission (the Commission), in consultation with its Committee of Scientific Advisors on Marine Mammals, has reviewed the above-referenced permit application with regard to the goals, policies, and requirements of the Marine Mammal Protection Act (the MMPA). Sea to Sea Productions is requesting authorization to conduct filming activities on gray seals off the coasts of Maine and New Hampshire for a Canadian Broadcasting Company series documenting the growth of the northeastern population of gray seals.

Sea to Sea Productions is requesting authorization to photograph and videotape gray seals off the Isle of Shoals during a five-day period. Individuals of any age class and either sex could be harassed. The filmmakers would implement various measures to minimize impacts on marine mammals and also would be required to abide by the National Marine Fisheries Service's (NMFS) standard permit conditions. The Commission believes that the proposed activities are consistent with the purposes and policies of the MMPA and recommends that NMFS issue the permit, as requested.
