Dear Ms. Harrison:

The Marine Mammal Commission (the Commission), in consultation with its Committee of Scientific Advisors on Marine Mammals, has reviewed the above-referenced permit application with regard to the goals, policies, and requirements of the Marine Mammal Protection Act (the MMPA). Plimsoll Productions is requesting authorization to conduct filming activities on pinnipeds in California for an upcoming series on the National Geographic Channel highlighting the sensory and communication capabilities of wildlife and plants.

Plimsoll Productions is requesting authorization to film<sup>1</sup> Northern elephant seals at Año Nuevo State Park for four weeks between January 2021 and March 2022. Individuals of any age class and either sex could be harassed. California sea lions, harbor seals and Steller sea lions also could be harassed incidental to the filming activities. A state park monitor would always accompany the filmmakers into the field, and Drs. Colleen Reichmuth, Patrick Robinson and Caroline Casey of the University of California at Santa Cruz would serve as off-site advisors and may also serve as on-site advisors. The filmmakers would implement various measures to minimize impacts on pinnipeds and also would be required to abide by the National Marine Fisheries Service's (NMFS) standard permit conditions.

In its application, Plimsoll Productions proposed to approach and film fighting male elephant seals on foot, monitoring the reaction of seals during the entire approach, yet it did not explicitly indicate whether filmmakers would avoid positioning themselves between fighting seals. To ensure the safety of the filmmakers and minimize possible disturbance to the seals, the Commission recommends that NMFS issue the permit contingent on prohibiting filmmakers from positioning themselves between fighting male elephant seals.
