Dear Ms. Harrison:

The Marine Mammal Commission (the Commission), in consultation with its Committee of Scientific Advisors on Marine Mammals, has reviewed the above-referenced permit application with regard to the goals, policies, and requirements of the Marine Mammal Protection Act (the MMPA). Minnesota Zoo is requesting authorization to maintain two non-releasable adult female Hawaiian monk seals during a five-year period. Seals would be cared for and maintained for enhancement purposes under section 10(a)(1)(A) of the Endangered Species Act and maintained under the authority of section 109(h)/112(c) of the MMPA for stranded animals under which they were brought into captivity. Minnesota Zoo holds exhibitor's license 41-C-0019 issued by the Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service under the Animal Welfare Act.

<u>The Commission</u> believes that the proposed activities are consistent with the purposes and policies of the MMPA and <u>recommends</u> that NMFS issue the permit, as requested. Kindly contact me if you have any questions concerning the Commission's recommendation.
